

District Ministerial Examining Board Minimum Standards

1. The man examined should agree with and be able to explain and defend each statement in the Statement of Faith.

2. To supplement the above, and because of the number of questions that the man may face in his ministry, the following items will also be required in the examination.
 - a. Be able to explain the importance and symbolism associated with Believers baptism and each part of the Communion service.

 - b. Be able to outline the history of the Brethren movement and differentiate between the various Brethren groups.

 - c. Be prepared to explain and defend his position on origins and Genesis 1-11.

 - d. Be prepared to explain and defend his position on the Charismatic movement, especially the areas of continuing revelation and the sign gifts.
